Part of an ice level indoor kit to be used inside a North American rink.

This indoor kit (the flexible blue pipe) is limited to one size only, because it is laid down against the continuous curve of the wooden support.

Images 1-4: The kit is held in place by the weight of the wood, a few 100 lbs sandbags (the black bundles on top of the wooden kit are sandbags covered with a plastic garbage bag) and screwed to the original board at three places (the end and the centers). In image 3, the inside of the goal crease should normally be lighter, please view the PDFs "ImportanceCourbeCurve".
