COMPARISON

55 B (natural environments) Pre requisite: COM 55 A

The following examples are strictly for educational purposes. They aim at comparing a natural environment exactly as originally found with a later stage that includes some minimal cleaning in order to simplify the visual communication. This visual simplification can be used to measure the cerebral activities by comparing it to the original. Forms that are vertically organized (live elements = parallel lines) and oblique and or horizontal (fallen branches and tree trunks = dead elements in a state of transformation = non parallel lines). The latter were MANUALLY removed.

These images are incomplete and are meant to measure the brain activities. Anyone thinking of doing something similar in any forest should spread around the remaining compost in its original space in the late Fall. The first image is the original.
